Transition Plan Committee

The Ohio Department of Developmental Disabilities (DODD) has established a committee to assist with the development of the Transition Plan to be submitted to the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) by March, 2015. The plan will indicate how Ohio will come into compliance with the new CMS rule that became effective in March, 2014. Among other things, this new rule emphasizes integrated services, increased employment and it stresses 'conflict free case management'. The committee will begin meeting in May and is expected to meet monthly. Superintendent Morison has been asked to participate on the committee.

Dream Field

In their May, 2014 meeting, the Franklin County Board of Developmental Disabilities passed a resolution in support of the Grove City Little League, which is building a fully accessible baseball field, called Dream Field.. This will be the second field of its kind in Franklin County. Dublin also has a similar field, which supports children and adults with disabilities.

The meeting is open to family members of individuals served by FCBDD and includes updates and discussions with the Superintendent.
