for the Sheriff's Department. The Board will consider the following
recommendation in their May 14 meeting (5:00pm at 2879 Johnstown
Road):

- ---Relocate the Living Skill Center services from Hague Avenue to Northeast on Hamilton Road in Gahanna
- ---Relocate Goodwill Work and Community Services to ARC South on Marketing Place Road in Groveport
- -- Commit to relocate both programs by January 1, 2016
