Ohio Opens ABLE (STABLE) Accounts

Ohio is the first state in the nation to launch STABLE Accounts where eligible individuals with disabilities are able to save money, invest money and spend money on qualified expenses such as healthcare, education, housing and transportation. Ohio Treasurer Josh Mandel has announced the launch of the accounts, which is made possible by the federal ABLE (Achieving a Better Life Experience) Act.
