

Water Testing Update

Water testing at the Board's buildings is still being conducted. Preliminary results indicate that legionella was **not** detected at all 16 locations. All drinking fountains at the buildings, except for one of the fountains at the Bixby Center, were reported with lead concentrations **below** the detection level. Out of an abundance of caution, we will temporarily disable the drinking fountains at Bixby Center and replace if further testing warrants. The only other locations where elevated lead levels were found were the boiler room at Northeast Center, the wash bay drain at Transportation East and a service connection line at ECLC.
