## Schedule Change for Preschools and West Central School

Due to the increased spread of the COVID-19 virus in the community and the impact that this has had on the preschools and West Central School of the Franklin County Board of Developmental Disabilities, services will shift from in-person classes to virtual lessons on Monday, December 7, 2020. The safety of students and staff continues to be our priority and we believe this shift in services is necessary to prevent further spread of the virus.

We will continue to evaluate the status of the virus and guidance from Health Officials to determine future schedules and plans. For now, we will change our school calendar to allow for a two week break of in-person classes after the holidays. Our revised calendar for December, 2020 and January, 2021 is as follows. (Because of additional days scheduled for Winter Recess, there will not be a Spring Recess in April, 2021. Services will be provided from April 5-9, 2021.)

- --December 7, 2020 to December 18, 2020—Virtual Services
- --December 21, 2020 to January 6, 2021—Winter Recess
- --January 7, 2021—January 15, 2021—Virtual Services
- --January 19, 2021—Tentative Start Date to Resume In-Person Services
