### **Vaccine Update from Franklin County Public Health**

Franklin County Public Health has received a vaccine allotment to offer first doses of COVID-19 vaccine, by appointment only, to people 65 years or older and those [with severe congenital, developmental or early onset disorders](#). For details about scheduling, use the [bit.ly/vax2normal](https://bit.ly/vax2normal) link instead of the regular FCPH website.

Appointments are being taken for Wednesday, Feb. 24; Thursday, Feb. 25; and Friday, Feb. 26.

While the vaccine supply is limited, many other providers also have some doses available for people in this Phase 1B group. Those eligible are encouraged to check with their primary care provider, hospital system or pharmacy to see whether vaccine is available.
