The Ohio Department of Developmental Disabilities (DODD), with partners throughout Ohio, is working toward a vision of collaboration among state agencies, communities, and networks of support where fathers of people with developmental disabilities are valued, engaged, and empowered. To best move forward, we want to know- "What is a father's current perspective? What are fathers' experiences in systems that support their child with developmental disabilities? What do they want?
