Help with Internet

Any household with an individual who receives Supplemental Security Income (SSI) is eligible to receive discounted internet service through the ACP (Affordable Connectivity Program). Social Security doesn't count ACP assistance as income or a resource for SSI purposes. Receipt of this assistance will not affect your SSI payment.

If you don't receive SSI or participate in another qualifying assistance program, you may also be eligible if your household income is at or below 200% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines.
